



NARROGIN TOWN HALL – RESTORATION PROJECT

COMMUNITY FORUM 2 in the TOWN HALL WEDNESDAY 11 NOVEMBER 2009 FROM 7.00 pm

In the Narrogin Community Survey held in February 2009, 23% of respondents listed restoration of the Narrogin Town Hall as the number one priority for expenditure of Royalties for Regions Funds. In response, Council has reserved \$938,000 in the 2009/2010 budget for restoration work to be undertaken at the Town Hall.

Much of the work will be directed towards standard building maintenance, and some of the work may be directed towards a number of internal redevelopments, such as:

- Relocation of the existing external toilets into the area known as “The Nexis Art Gallery”

- Demolition of the existing external toilets and construction of a suitable storage room in the vacant space.

- Excavation of the rear outdoor area to match the level of the Town Hall floor, for the creation of an outdoor plaza.

- Extension of the drinks servery to improve bar /drink service

Council will hold a Forum to gain community input into these and any other proposed redevelopments of the Town Hall. Community members are invited to attend the Forum to be held in the Town Hall on Wednesday 11 November 2009 from 7.00 pm.
