- 1. It shall not be placed within 9m of the existing edge of the bitumen seal;
- 2. It will need to be located at least 325m from the Pethybridge Road intersection;
- 3. An engineering certificate will be required to ensure its structural adequacy;
- 4. It shall be designed and constructed so as to be frangible;
- 5. Agreement that the area surrounding the sign/structure is maintained;
- 6. Hold public liability insurance to indemnity the local government against any claim, action or process for damage and/or injury in relation to the installation or existence of the sign; and
- 7. Detail if any existing vegetation needs to be removed or trimmed.
