In 2016, the Upper Great Southern Hockey Association (UGSHA) hosted an international hockey series between the Australian Kookaburra's and Great Britain. Mareesa volunteered to be the canteen manager for the event. This required her to organise two dinner functions, providing meals for almost 3000 people over two days, including both teams and their support staff.

The compliments that the association received as a result were too numerous to mention, and she played a pivotal role in the success of the event.

In addition Mareesa has worked as a volunteer in a range of roles including:

- School canteens for 9 years;
- Little Athletics for 7 years;
- Minkey hockey coach for 3 years;
- Secretary of the UGSHA for 3 years;
- Volunteer Team Manager, Carnival and Country week coordinator of the UGSHA for over 10 years; and
- Canteen manager of the UGSHA for 8 years.

In December 2016 Mrs Atkins received recognition at the Shire of Narrogin's Thank a Volunteer Day event, and on Australia Day 2018 she received the Shire of Narrogin's Citizen of the Year Award in recognition of her outstanding community service.

#### 9.1 2019 LIVE MUSIC AND MOVIE EVENTS

There was some discussion by the Committee regarding the Australia Day events held in Mackie Park in the afternoon. For three years the Shire has coordinated additional free activities in Mackie Park featuring live music and an outdoor movie. While community feedback from those who attended was positive, attendance at each of these has consistently been very low.

The consensus of the Committee was unanimous that these additional activities would not be offered as part of the Shire's Australia Day celebrations in 2020. The Committee's efforts should be focussed on the coordination and professional delivery of the Community Breakfast and the continual improvement of the on-stage formalities.

#### 9.2 DONUTS

There was an additional discussion regarding the provision of donuts at the Community Breakfast. Historically this task was undertaken by Officers of the former Shire of Narrogin as their contribution to the event, however, it has become increasingly difficult to arrange additional volunteers to undertake this. The Committee agreed that as lamingtons are an Australian dessert, they should replace donuts at future Australia Day Community Breakfasts. The ASO will arrange the supply of lamingtons as part of the event catering.

There being no further business to discuss, the Presiding Member declared the meeting closed at 5.37 pm.
