

With dry conditions effecting many parts of New South Wales, it's time to think about cleaning out your sheds and your property of used agvet containers and unused chemicals.

Even through busy periods during the year farmers need to be aware of the requirements for safe and effective disposal of their used chemicals and containers.

It is also just good farm practice, which ensures your family and employees stay safe.

- Gather up any used agvet containers. If they're drumMUSTER eligible get them to your nearest collection site for recycling. Remember, your local community groups raise funds through the collection of drumMUSTER containers.
- If you have unused or obsolete agvet chemicals, register these with ChemClear for collection. You will be notified when a collection is happening in your area.
