I hope you're all enjoying the summer and staying safe as we head into February. There's a lot happening in our community this month, and I'm excited to share some important updates with you.

First, mark your calendars for the Welcome to Narrogin event on 20 February 2025, from 4:00 pm to 7:00 pm at the Narrogin Regional Leisure Centre. This event is a wonderful opportunity to meet new faces, connect with long-standing community members, and see what Narrogin has to offer. We hope to see you all there!

On a more operational note, I want to inform our valued Narrogin Regional Homecare clients about an upcoming change. In July 2025, Homecare Packages will transition to the Support @ Home funding model. I want to assure everyone that there is absolutely nothing to be concerned about—we are committed to making this transition as smooth and seamless as possible.

As part of the process, we will be updating agreements to reflect the new funding structure. Expect to sign a new agreement in the coming months. This will ensure that all relevant information is clearly outlined and up to date. Rest assured, we will keep you informed every step of the way and are here to answer any questions you may have.

Additionally, I want to share some important health news. People aged 65 years and over can now access a free shingles vaccination under the National Immunisation Program (NIP). Shingles causes a painful, blistering rash and can lead to long-term nerve pain that may last for months. In rare cases, it can cause serious illness. As people get older, the risk of developing shingles and complications increases.

Vaccination is a safe and effective way to protect yourself from this disease. If you or a family member are eligible, talk to your health professional about the free shingles vaccine.







