The winners for this year are:

- 2nd Prize – (Value \$200): 27 Furnival Street, Narrogin
- 3rd Prize – (Value \$150): 10 Dalglish Street, Narrogin

The Best CBD Business Window was judged by Narrogin Chamber of Commerce and the winners are:

- 1st Prize – (Value \$150): Knightline
- 2nd Prize – (Value \$50): Wild & Waste Free

The judges commended Cr Broad on his display, and congratulated previous winners for their displays this year. The best decorated street was Furnival Street, and the judges say it is worth a drive to view it.

It was obvious that the CBD businesses put in an extraordinary effort and the CBD is looking very festive indeed.
