



# Wheatbelt Athlete Support Program (WASP)

## SPORT SUPPORT FUNDING GUIDELINES

WASP Sport Support Funding (SSF) is accessible by State Sporting Associations (SSAs) who deliver services within the Wheatbelt Region; to enhance talent development programs and pathways within the region and to provide additional sport specialist services that support the development of high performance athletes, coaches and officials.

Preference will be given to applications that provide extension opportunities for athletes, coaches or officials.

### To be eligible for WASP Sport Support Funding applicants should:

- **Contact the WASP Co-ordinator prior to submitting an application.**
- Provide services to sports and individuals within the Wheatbelt Region.
- Be able to demonstrate a partnership with the relevant sporting Club or Association based in the Wheatbelt.
- Demonstrate consideration of future sustainability of the program.
- Demonstrate that the proposed program sits outside the SSAs core business delivery model.
- Support and display the values of True Sport to the best of their ability and encourage Association/Club members to do the same.

### Eligible items include:

- Delivery of sports specialist coaching and programs for high performance athletes or those in the pathway. Inclusion of mentoring and support for local coaches/officials is encouraged.
- Costs associated with providing tailored exercise programs to sports specific athletes and/or across multi sports. Inclusion of mentoring and support for local coaches/officials is encouraged.
- Costs associated with providing specialist coaching/officiating within the Wheatbelt region – working with selected Wheatbelt coaches/officials.
- Costs associated with delivering training and education programs that sit outside the SSAs current Regional Servicing Plan.

### Ineligible items include:

- Programs that are delivered outside the Wheatbelt region.
- Equipment or uniform costs.
- Catering costs.
- Any program that sits within SSAs current Regional Servicing Plan.

**SSF applications for between \$500 and \$2,000 can be submitted.**

**Applications must be submitted to this office no less than 30 days before program dates commence.**
