The Committee members present discussed and agreed to the following arrangements:

- 1. Number of volunteers to assist with delivery of catering and front of house services from **6.00 am Wednesday 26 January 2022:**
 - a. Volunteers to commence setting up from 6.00 am:
 - b. Complete stage setup and decorate;
 - c. David Harrison is bringing his own sound equipment, and will require assistance to set up;
 - d. A quantity of seats in from of the stage for invited guests;
 - e. Tables and chairs set up on the lawn for about 100; and
 - f. Volunteers will set up large marquees from 6.30am at locations to be determined on arrival.
- 2. Consensus agreement to the proposed layout and setup:
 - a. Layout to be the same as last year;
 - b. Stage to only be one level;
 - c. Narrogin Racing have indicated that the cover on the shelter is damaged and will not be replaced in time for the event; and
 - d. Menu to consist of bacon, scrambled eggs, sausages along with bread and rolls, as well as vegetarian sausages, baked beans and a vegetable bake.

Allergens are to be considered, as well as dietary considerations (vegetarian/vegan option)

 - a. The onstage program will be written and times adjusted to accommodate the number of Citizenship Pledges
 - b. Cr Early to discuss with Vanessa Ward
- 4. Consensus agreement to the proposed program:

 - c. There are 10 citizenship ceremonies
