4. MATTERS FOR DISCUSSION / INFORMATION

4.1 NRLC MURAL UPDATE

The final design as decided by the TAC was circulated to Council via email on 5 August 2024 to seek consensus support on the design so the project could move forward to the implementation stage. During this time, with regard to the indigenous content in the final design by Indigenous Artist Fiona, mural Artist Jerome, advised that he has been unable to contact Fiona, after trying on numerous occasions, which has now caused complications in the process and may delay the project. A delay with this project is not ideal nor warranted.

Due to the Indigenous Artist Fiona being uncontactable, and the project needing to progress, Artist Jerome was requested to remove Fiona's content from the final design and include some indigenous depictions that are relevant to the Narrogin Community.

See attached amended concept from Artist Jerome for the TAC to discuss for Council consensus endorsement via email.

Should option 1 be unachievable then revert to option 2.

Option 2: Artist Jerome to reduce the size of the shearer in proportion to the size of the depicted footballers. Replace female with male indigenous shearer. Replace trees in top left corner with farm silos in the background.

5. MATTERS WHICH REQUIRE DECISIONS

5.1 NARROGIN CEMETERY CONCEPT – "CEMETERY REFLECTION BROOK"

The TAC are presented with a concept improvement of a storm water drain partly running through the Cemetery for discussion and consideration regarding the TAC's desire to implement this project by recommendation to Council. This concept landscape design is referred to as "Reflection Brook"

The Shire's Chief Executive Officer (CEO) tasked the Executive Manager Technical & Rural Services (EMTRS) to draft a concept design on an existing stormwater drain that runs through the Cemetery. The brief was to create and design as natural (as possible) water feature (Brook) to improve the aesthetics of an otherwise eroded storm water drain.

Storm water flow through the drain only occurs during times of rain where the stormwater runs through the drain, under Grainger Street, and disperses into natural bush land. The EMTRS, thought to create two rock and sedge holding pools to beautify the drain, incorporating the natural trees that exist there and also to plant new trees in keeping with the TAC's recent decision on the species of trees to be planted at the Cemetery – Agonus flexuosa.

The use of some natural large bush rocks that are located on site could also be incorporated into the setting as features and potentially could be used by the community to place approved plaques in remembrance of loved ones that have passed and may not be placed at the Cemetery?

In consultation with the Manager of Operations, the cost of the project is estimated to be \$18,500 taking into consideration all aspects of the design including earthworks, plant, labour and materials.

The TAC is requested to consider the project and the cost to implement it, and whether the TAC wish to recommend the concept to Council for consideration in a future Budget.




