
Over time, towns change. This project captures a moment in time for Narrogin in a format that is familiar, fun and lasting.

### How the Project Is Funded

A fundraising silent auction is a central part of the project.

Businesses and community groups are invited to participate by bidding for:

- Business spaces on the board
- Utility and tax squares
- Community Chest cards
- Chance cards

Funds raised through the auction contribute to the production of the game and help ensure the project proceeds with strong community support.

### How Places on the Board Are Allocated


Places on the Narrogin MONOPOLY board are allocated through a transparent, category-based silent auction process.

Business board spaces and card sponsorships are offered via auction, with each space representing one business or community group only.

Each auction item falls within a defined category. The top bidder for each item wins that space or card, and the winning bid determines the sponsorship tier received.

Industry groupings are used to ensure balanced representation across the board. This approach ensures diversity, clarity, and local authenticity.

### How the Silent Auction Works

The auction will be run through the **GalaBid** platform. **Online bidding opens on 6 March 2026.**

Registered participants will be able to:

- View available auction categories and items
- Place and increase bids during the auction period
- See the current highest bids in real time
- Receive notifications if they are outbid or if bidding is about to close
- Complete payment securely once the auction closes

The auction will formally close at the Silent Auction Dinner at **9:00pm on Friday, 20 March 2026**, when bidding will be locked, and bids consolidated.

The standard MONOPOLY instruction remains unchanged in accordance with licensing requirements.

Example: **DOCTOR'S FEES. PAY \$50.**

Custom local text (provided by bidder):  
**YOU DISCOVER CROQUET AT THE NARROGIN CROQUET CLUB AND SIGN UP FOR MEMBERSHIP. PAY \$50.**
