It is proposed that the newly constructed Wanerie Road Heavy Haulage route and the connecting section of Cooraminning Road to Williams Road be limited to 80km/hr for the length of the heavy haulage route.

Background

With the Wanerie Road Extension being completed, contact has been made from several parties being the Narrogin Agricultural College and Narrogin Hay Plant, both requesting that the speed limit be reduced to 80km/hr for the length of the bypass for safety reasons. Main Roads is awaiting advice from the Shire as to the recommended speed limit.

Comment

As provided in the background, two requests have been presented to Council for the speed limit to be limited to 80km/hr for the Wanerie Road and Cooraminning Road Heavy Haulage route due to safety concerns. The recommendation is to advise Main Roads that it is the Shire's request for the speed limit to be 80km/hr.

With the traffic from students and parents that attend the Narrogin Agricultural College the proposed speed limit of 80km/hour will ensure a reduced risk to this traffic. Narrogin Hay also requested the speed limitation due to the time taken to stop fully loaded vehicles.

In the instance that 80km/hr is not acceptable, Council could recommend an alternative limit of 90km/hr or even to leave the speed limit open up to 110km/hr. However the speed reduction will in addition reduce the number of pedestrian vehicles utilising the road for through traffic, especially tourists.

Hi Aaron,

Firstly we congratulate the Town of Narrogin for completion of this infrastructure upgrade and look forward to completion of the next bypass stage at the southern end of town. Narrogin Hay has some concerns associated with the extension of Wanerie Road through to Great Southern Highway once the extension is operational. We understand at this time, the old section of the road is 110Km/hr. Our concern is now that the road will be very busy as it will possibly attract additional traffic bypassing the Town of Narrogin. Also speed can build up to 110 much easier over distance. We would request for the speed limit to be reduced past our work site (200 Wanerie Road Narrogin) to 60kmph.

Narrogin hay has 15-20 Hay trucks (B-Doubles and Road Trains), 10 Container Road Trains (5 day and 5 night) and 25 employee vehicles plus contractor/visitor vehicles entering/exiting site on a daily basis. During intake season Hay truck numbers are up to 35-40 trucks daily. We are concerned that traffic on Wanerie road will not have time to stop safely, once Narrogin Hay is in clear view, should there be a road train turning into or out of our site. We are also very concerned for large trucks travelling along Wanerie Road at a speed that small vehicles may be at risk entering/exiting our site.

In addition to the speed limit reduction we would request that there be no overtaking along the old section of Wanerie road (From Mokine Road to Cooraminning Road) as it would be a very high risk accident zone. Also we would suggest that highly visible CAUTION TRUCKS ENTERING signage be in place at lease 200m each side of our entrance.

Under section 21 of the Workplace Health and Safety Act (extract below) we have a duty of care to ensure the Health and safety of our employees/contractors as far as reasonably practicable.

21. Duties of employers and self-employed persons

(1) A self-employed person shall take reasonable care to ensure his or her own safety and health at work.

(2) An employer or self-employed person shall, so far as is practicable, ensure that the safety or health of a person, not being (in the case of an employer) an employee of the employer, is not adversely affected wholly or in part as a result of —

(a) work that has been or is being undertaken by —
(i) the employer or any employee of the employer; or

(ii) the self-employed person;

or

(b) any hazard that arises from or is increased by —
(i) the work referred to in paragraph (a); or
(ii) the system of work that has been or is being operated by the employer or the self-employed person.
